You can borrow books, music, videos, equipment, board games and other material at the checkout desk. You need your WOU student ID to borrow materials.

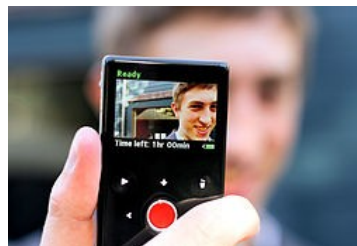
## COMPUTERS



We have computers on the 1st and 2nd floor and in the student lounge.

The building has wireless access for your laptop and other devices.

## EQUIPMENT



Available equipment includes cameras, video and audio recorders, microphones, headphones and headsets, Wii system, peripherals, and more.

## PRINTERS



We have B/W and color printers on the 1st and 2nd floor and in the student lounge.

## COPY CENTER



The KIC is a face-up, color scanner that saves to various file formats.

We also have B/W copiers, flatbed Scanners, and microfilm/microfiche readers.

## STUDY AREAS



We have study tables, carrels, and study areas for group or individual study throughout the library.
